- 6. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE ORGANISATION:
 - a) The Organization aims to achieve the following Social Service activities aimed at improving the living conditions and economical standard of the poor and general agricultural development such as farmers, landless agricultural labours, small and marginal farmers, poor and general welfare, particularly of Tribal, Adivasis, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and General Farmers etc.
 - b) To conceive agriculture as a package of technology skill and cultivation by use of abuse materials of the harvest crops after processing the main crops.
 - c) To help the other Societies, propagate the principles to Technical agricultural develop ideas like Biofertilizers, Agro-Forestry, Mixed agriculture, Awareness about horticulture crops, Under rate crisis fro crop production, development of awareness in the field of environment, land scaving, development of new farms, education and training, implementation of better system and (Exchange of Crops product), remote sensoring programmes, water-shade and harvesting management programme and research etc. shall be conduct by the organisation.

d) To generate demand for cultivating, ploughing, from the families within its area of operation

- e) To assist the farmers, by making farmers co-operative management groups / making available institutional finance for seasonal crops.
- f) To work against corruption and to undertake activities towards administrative reforms and development planning.
- g) To establish effective interest co-ordination between Government farms / NGO's / Professional Bodies / Agricultural functionaries and other donors from State, National and International etc. and for term loans and its timely delivery of inputs required for agricultural development.
- h) To motivate and mobilize the farmers/societies adopting cost effective and technologically suitable houses for APL, BPL and Landless people organisation shall be right to create self help groups and community management groups etc.

 - vi) To engage in programmes of education in general and in particular, primary, adult, non-formal, vocational and other latest Technical educational systems for development in rural and urban areas.
 - vii) To promote all manner of cultural activities that will serve to enrich the live of people.
 - viii) To promote preservations of environment and ecology.
 - ix) To promote appropriate technology and renewable and non-conventional sources of energy.
 - x) To act as a resource Center for training, research documentation and consultancy for development to eradicate polarity from the society.
 - xi) To eradiate illiteracy from the society.
 - xii) To develop equal opportunities and vocational training for women and rural youth.
 - xiii) To develop child education and health.
 - xiv) To give medical facilities to the people.
 - xv) To preserve village forest and plant different types of trees.

- xvi) To expend constructional activities like dug well, nallah, building, bridge, road, pond, tube well and chua etc.
- xvii) To develop literacy personalities among the rural youth.
- xviii) To facilitate and enhance rural artisans craftsman to advance their culture.
- xix) The aforementioned objects shall be carried on for the benefit of the poor and needy, irrespective of caste, rotem community or creed as such in both rural and urban areas.

The objects incidental or ancillary, the main objects are :-

- To collaborate/affiliate with voluntary agencies and other agencies and Government in developmental activities and relief programmes.
- To organize/conduct seminar, promote and administer recreation Centers reading rooms and related activities.
- iii. Enter into such contracts or agreements as the Society may think fit for the purposes of the Society and for such or any of those purpose to retain or from time to time, employ and remove skilled, unskilled, professionals and pay for their services, such as fees, remunerations of any such proportion thereof, as the society in its decretion considers expedient.
- iv. To borrow money at the time of need of the Society upon such terms and such securities as may be determined.
- v. To invest the moneys of the Society nor immediately, required upon such securities or otherwise in such manner as may from time to time determined.
- vi. To accept, hold or administer any gift, donation or construction in mind, money, whether upon trust or otherwise and to undertake or execute any trust or obligation on which, may be deemed conclusive to any of the objects of the Society.
- vii. Generally, to purchase, take on lease or in exchange hire or otherwise acquire any real or personal property or any interests therein, and any rights, easements, privileges which is society may think necessary and convenient with reference to any of the objects of the Society / organisation.
- viii. To raise funds, undertake and hold such schemes, projects investments, industry or any other activities which may generate funds for the Society to implement the objects of the Society.
- To draw, make accept, endorse, discount, execute, and issue cheques, promissory notes and other negotiable or transferable instruments.

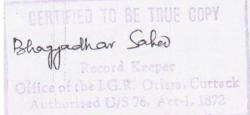

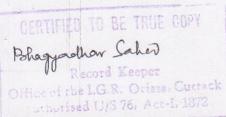

BY-LAWS OF THE 'TRIRANGA YUBAKA SANGHA'

(A Voluntary Organisation Registered Under Societies Registration Act. XXI of 1860)

1. NAME:

Name of the Organization shall be: "TRIRANGA YUBAKA SANGHA"

2. LOCATION:

Location of the Registered Office of the Organization shall be At – Mahakhanda, Po - Rengali, Block – Agalpur, PS- Loisingha, G.P – Budula, Dist.-Bolangir - 767001, Orissa (INDIA).

3. DATE OF ESTABLISHMENT:

The society has been established on 03.01.1999 these rules shall be called the rules and regulations of the society.

4. AREA OF OPERATION:

The Area of operation of the Organization is State Level. At any place of State of Orissa this organization can undertake any programme for the benefit of people.

5. REGISTRATION NUMBER:

5019-306 of 1999-2000 of XXI of 1860 dtd. 19th March 2000.

6. INTERPRETATION:

These rules shall be interpreted in pursuance with the provisions laid down have under and in case of disputes, shall be interpreted as per the provisions of the societies registration Act XXI of 1860.

7. **DEFINATIONS**:

For the purpose of these Bye-laws:

In these rules and regulations unless the context otherwise required, words and expressions have the following meanings:

(a) Title, Name and Location:

The Society/Organization means the Society/Organisation established under the Memorandum of the Organisation of: "TRIRANGA YUBAKA SANGHA", At – Mahakhanda, Po – Rengali, Block – Agalpur, PS- Loisingha, G.P. – Budula, Dist.-Bolangir - 767001, Orissa (INDIA) and may be shifted to any other place in Orissa as area as the Governing Body decide from time to time.

(b) Jurisdiction:

The scope of activities of the Society shall be extended to all the villages with in the state and may extended to other areas by the approval of Managing Director after general body meeting of the Society.

8. Advisors:

The advisors means the legal advisors of the organisation selected by the Managing Director.

(a) Managing Director:

Means the Director of the Organisation who is the 1st citizen among the founder member of the society/organization.

(b) General Body:

The General Body means the General Body as constructed under these rules.

(c) Governing Body:

The Governing Body means the Governing Body of the Organisation, formed as provided by these rules and regulations.

(d) President:

The president means the President of the Organisation.

(e) Vice-President:

The Vice-President means the Vice-President of the Organization.

(f) Secretary

The Secretary means the secretary of the Organisation who shall be the Ex-officio Secretary of the Organisation.

(g) Treasurer-Cum-Cashier:

The Treasurer means the Treasurer of the Organisation who shall deal with the cash & cash related Account and records of the Organisation.

(h) N.G.O.:

The N. G. O. means a non-government organisation, duly registered and providing services on voluntary basis with profit or no profit basis.

(i) S. H. G.:

The S. H. G. means a self help Group Created among the rural and urban A.P.L. & B.P.L. category people to gain the benefits from government and N.G. O. sectors to develop their living standards.

(j) C.M.G.:

The C.M.G. means a body of persons sharing the same Social Development in particular region under their bye-law duly registered/to be registration under the Society Registration Act 1860 also may conducted by this Society by their applications for source of funds and legal assistance.

(k) F.C.M.G. :

The F.C.M.G. means the farmers community management group of each GramPanchayat, which should be registered under the societies registration Act. 1860 may be create / adopt by this society /organisation for proper concern with finance and legal assistance.

(l) Professional Consultants:

Means professionals working as specializing any planning and develop of the farmers, for environmental programme etc. And other related fields of this society / organisation.

(m) Special Resolution;

Means a resolution passed by the majority of not less than three fourth of the members of the society present in person in Governing Body called for the purpose is final.

(n) Wards importing the singular numbers shall be deemed to include the plural and vice-versa and words importing the measculing gender shall be deemed to include the feminine gender.

9. RESPONSIBILITY AUTHORITY & CONTROLS

A) To Take responsibility:

It is incumbent for the S.H.G./C.M.G/F.C.M.G Society/N. G. O.'s to take responsibility for meeting the basic needs in its totality of the member-families (under APL and BPL category) in the rural and urban areas under the Organization. The organization shall not discriminate any willing member / organization by reason of gender blindness and admit him virtue of gender equality by according due status to both man and women organizations.

B) To Exercise Authority:

The SHG/C.M.G./ F.C. M.G./ Society/ N.G.O. the legitimate right to take decision including financial, regarding the systems of providing basic needs, both in quantitative and qualitative terms and on behalf of the users members. The Organization will have the right to de-recognize the societies if the society fails to comply with its requirements.

C) To exercise control:

The societies/N. G. O.'s /C.M.G./ F.C.M.G. carry out and determine the outcome of its decisions relating to planning, financing , implementing the latest agriculture technology and (including environmental issues). And also recovery of loans/dues/fees from the users in prescribed time.

10. MEMBERSHIP:

- (a) The subscriber to the memorandum of Organization and all such persons, who may be admitted from time to time, only by the invitation of Governing Body and have signed the role of the members there of, shall be the members of the Society.
- (b) The persons within the age groups of 18-65 years irrespective of caste, creed, sex and can be a member of the Organization. Also a person can apply to the Managing Director of the organization for membership, if there is vacant in member post by paying membership fees.

The members will be known as follows:

- i) Individual Members:
 - Any person within the age group of 18-65 irrespective of caste, creed, sex can be individual member by applying in a plain paper and by paying of the fees.
- ii) Institutional Members:
 - Any institution or organization involved in rural development work can be institutional member by applying in plain paper and by paying the fees.
- iii) Founder Member:
 - All the member who took interest in forming the organization in the very beginning are known as founder member. The first founder member shall known as Managing Director.
- iv) Life Member:
 - Any person within the age group of 18-65 irrespective of caste, creed, sex can be life member by applying in a plain paper and by paying of the fees.

11. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

- i) A person shall ceased to be a member of the organization if he resigns, dies Becomes unsound minded of is declared insolvent by Court of law of is convicted of any criminal offence involving moral tempted.
- ii) Any member who fails to attend three meeting consequently shall cease to be a member if he not given sufficient explanation for his absence to the satisfaction of the president.
- iii) If a member is engaged in activities detrimental to the aims and objects of the Organization, the organization would have the right to terminate his membership.
- iv) Any member would have the right to revoke his membership in submitting a written notice to the president of the organization.
- iv) A member should have fails to pay monthly subscription for a period exceeding three moths his/her membership will be terminated automatically.
- v) Membership will be terminated by special resolution.

12. MEMBERSHIP FEES:

Individual member fees Rs. 201/- per year. b) Institutional member fees Rs. 501/- per year. c) Founder member fees Rs. 101/- per year. d) Life member fees



13. RENEWAL OF MEMBERSHIP:

The members whose membership date is expired are entitled to receive the notice before the two months of the expiry date to renew their membership in the organization. So membership can be renewed by paying Rs.50/- as renewal fees. For institutional members as decided by Managing Director or Governing Body.

RIGHTS AND PREVILIAGES OF MEMBERS: 14.

Subject to the provisions of rules, the members of the organization shall have the following right.

- i) Each member can caste one Vote.
- Member can attend meetings and give opinion in General Body meeting. ii)
- At any dis-satisfaction on my decision of Governing Body any members will convey to iii) the Managing Director by application

CHANGE OF MEMBERS ADDRESS: 15.

If there is any change in address of the member, the member must write an application to the Managing Director after clearing all outstanding dues and with the final decision of the Governing Body she/he can resign form his/her membership.

16. CEASATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

- Membership ceases when a member die.
- ii) Membership ceases when resignation of a member is accepted by the Governing Body.
- iii) Membership ceases when a member becomes unsound and insolvent.
- iv) Membership ceases when a member convicts with offences involving in moral torpitude.
- Membership date is expired and no application is received by the governing Body before 2 months of expiry date.

17. THE GOVERNING BODY:

- The Governing Body of the Organization shall consist of a minimum of eleven members including the chief Executives.
- ii) All the members will be elected from the general Body.
- iii) The Governing Body shall hold offices for 5(Five) years at a time and that period shall and always with the conclusion of an annual Body meeting.
- An elected/appointed member may retire from office on giving notice in writing to the Governing Body.
- v) If an elected member ceases to hold office for any reason whatsoever, at any time the Governing Body may appoint any member to hold office in his place for the rest of the term,.
- vi) The Governing body shall have full power to act not with standing any vacancy that may not have been filled up.

18. POWER OF THE GOVERNING BODY:

The Governing Body shall have full power to do all such acts or things as may be necessary to carry out the objects of the society and for the management of all its affairs or which in its advance the objects of the society in particular, the said governing Body is authorized to do, among others, the following acts and things.

- To manage and superintend the affairs of the society and to exercise all such powers of the Society as are not under the statutes of the regulations required to be exercised by the society in the Governing Body.
- ii) To conduct the meetings and regulate own proceedings.
- iii) To appoint/terminate professional, technical, practical, commercial personnel or advisors or any other personnel for such purposes as shall be beneficial to the Society.
- iv) To establish such committees as it considers necessary or desirable to assist it if in carrying out its responsibilities and to delegate to such committees necessary powers and authorities.
- v) To exercise responsibilities over the affairs and activities of the Society and to lay down general policy on its behalf.
- vi) To establish and abolish various administrative posts and officers and fix duties and terms of employment related to them to engage suitable personnel, exercise control and deal administrative contingencies, objections and supervisions.
- vii) To establish procedure for selecting and supervising project of the Society.

- viii) To draw up and prevent to all members in annual report on the Societies activities, income and expenditure and externally audited statements of accounts.
- To commence, prosecute, defend or appear in continue compromise, abandon, contest or submit to any criminal civil, administrative, revenue, municipal arbitration conciliation or other proceedings or inquiry for the furtherance of or in conjunction with any objects of the society and to appoint retaining agents, attorneys, advocates or solicitors thereof.

19. MEETINGS OF THE GOVERNING BODY.

- (a) The Governing Body shall meet at least once in every six months at such places and times as they may from time to time.
- (b) A meeting of the Governing Body may at any time be called by the managing Director.
- (b) The Managing Director shall call meeting of the Governing Body on the written request of five or more members of the Governing Body.
- (c) All meeting will be presided over by president of the Governing Body of the Organization. In absence of president, Vice-President will preside.

20. COMPOSITION OF GENERAL BODY :

The General Body is composed of three types of ordinary members, those are:

- i) Individual member
- ii) Institutional member
- iii) Founder member
- iv) Life member

21. GENERAL BODY MEETING:

- (a) The Society held a general meeting of all its members in each year. The meeting is known as Annual General Body meeting. It shall convened for the following purposes:
 - (i) To receive annual report of the Society/Organization.
 - (ii) To receive the accounts of the Society/Organization.
 - (iii) To appoint the Society/Organization.
 - (iv) To elect the members of the Governing Body at every fifth years Annual General Body meeting.
- (b) The Secretary may whenever he thinks fit from a requisition made in writing signed by five members of the society stating the object of the meeting convened a General Body meeting of the Society.

- (c) The Quorum of the General Body meeting shall be 1/3rd of the members of the Society.
- (d) A President shall be elected from the members of the General Body present at the meeting by a simple majority of votes.
- (e) All questions at any general body meeting shall be decided by a simple majority of votes and if the votes be equally the president shall have an additional or casting vote.
- (f) At any General meeting every member shall one vote each.

22. DUTIES OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:

President:

President will preside over the each Governing Body meeting and all the activities will be carried out with the consultation of President.

Vice President:

In the absence of President, the Vice-president will act for the president.

Secretary:

- i) The Secretary is the Chief Executive/Chief functionary of the Organization.
- ii) The Secretary shall be elected by the members of Governing Body of the Society.
- iii) The Secretary is the supreme authority and will act for five years in the society from the date of election and appointment.
- The Secretary shall terminate, dismiss any members of General Body and Governing Body if necessary subject to improvement of society after approval of Managing Director.
- The Secretary will be elected after 5 years of society/organization from the date of appointment.
- vi) The Secretary is responsible for implementing the policies laid down by the Governing Body.
- vii) The Secretary shall have powers to appoint and terminate any person or persons for the Society/Organization and projects.

- viii) The Secretary shall call all meeting of Governing Body and General Body.
- The Secretary shall prepare and keep record of the membership of the Society and a record of minutes of proceedings of every meetings of the Governing Body and General Body, and other committees in a Book or books kept for that purpose. Such minutes of the proceedings of the meetings shall be signed by the President of the meeting and the Secretary.
- x) The Secretary shall have the power to operate any account of the society at nay Nationalized Bank. To deposit and draw money he is empowered alone, after the approval of managing Director
- The Secretary in the authorized person on behalf of the Governing Body of the Society to execute bonds, enter in to agreements, pay the staff, receive loans, and public donations and entitle with legal affairs of the society from time to time and to be the contract person of the Society from time to time and to be the contract person for each scheme/project on behalf of the organization.
- xii) The Secretary may be paid the Honorarium by the Organization depending on his performance. In absence of the Secretary the President of Governing Body shall nominate any one of the member of the Organization to act/function as Secretary for a temporary period by special resolution approved by the Managing Director.
- xiii) The Secretary shall be due to be sued on behalf of the Organization from time to time.

23. FUNDS OF THE ORGANIZATION:

- * Sale of Sala seeds/Sala leafs and kendu leafs.
- Physical Labour.
- * From fares and festivals.
- * Loans.
- * In any other Legitimate manner.
- * Donations from local, State, National and International Governments and Other donor NGOs. Etc.
- (b) The Income and property of the Organization from what ever source derived shall be spent solely for the promotion of the aims and objectives as set for in the memorandum of the Organization.

(c) General funds:

General funds of organization crated through membership subscriptions, public donations self-income generating activities etc., will from the general funds of the organization and shall be deposited in any scheduled or nationalized bank in the name of the organization and this account will be jointly operated by a secretary and treasurer. The account of such funds will have to be maintained by the secretary and the annual statements/audited statements etc. have to be produced by him before the executive committee/general body meeting for approval.

(d) Project Funds:

Grants and other financial assistances received from any funding and assisting agencies both Govt. & non Govt. sources and foreign sources will from "Project Funds" of the organization. Such funds will be deposited in separate accounts in any scheduled Nationalized Banks and will be operated by the Secretary along single handled. Such accounts shall be maintained by the Secretary and shall be presented where ever necessary after approval of Managing Directors.

24. ACCOUNT:

The Bank account(s) shall be opened in the name of the Secretary and Treasurer and all checks and other transactions there on shall be signed by the Secretary and Treasurer who were the authorized persons by the Governing Body. The account/s of the organization will be operated by the Secretary alone.

25. AUDIT:

- The Secretary is the person who will propose auditor or auditors for the organization. Annually the Cash Book will be audited and all the documents of the auditor will be signed by the Secretary.
- ii) The financial year of the Organization shall be from 1st April to 31st March.
- Once at least in every year the accounts of the Society shall be examined and the correctness of the balance sheet ascertained by one or more qualified auditor or Govt. Auditors.

26. FUNCTIONS OF THE ORGANIZATION:

Besides the General acts enumerated in the objects of the Organization, it shall be the function of the Organization.

(a) To collect money and to spend in different programmes subject to public welfare.

27. AMENDMENTS:

To alter, extend or abridge memorandum of Association and/or the rules and regulations of the Society, the Governing Body may submit the proposition to the members of the Society in a written report and may concern a special meeting for consideration thereof. Amendment will be made as per the necessity of the Society on many aspects of the Society as per section 12 of SL Act.

No such proposition shall be carried in to effect, unless such report shall have been delivered or sent by post to every members of the society ten days previous to the special meeting convened by the Governing Body for consideration thereof nor unless such proposition shall have been agreed to the vote of three fifth of the members delivered in person or proxy and confirmed meeting convened by the Governing Body at an interval of one month after the former meeting.

28. QUROUM:

- The Quorum necessary for meetings of the Governing Body shall be two third of the Governing Body members.
- ii) A resolution or a proposal circulated by the managing Director to all members of the Governing body and approved and signed by the majority of members.

29. CHANGE OF PLACE OF REGISTERED OFFICE/HEAD OFFICE:

The situation of registered office/title/status of the organization will be changed as per the decisions taken unanimously by the Governing Body. Regarding this the Secretary's proposal is acceptable by all the members of the Governing Body after approval of Managing Director.

30. DISSOLUTION:

The Organization can be dissolved upon the decision made, in the General Body meeting for which Managing Director will circulate a notice before do days of the holding of the meeting.

31. MEETINGS:

Emergency meetings can be called or held at any time as per the need of the Society. A notice will be circulated by the secretary before 7 days of notice the meeting will be held and resolution will be made.
